Music

Overview

Music (SL) is provided as one of the subject choices in the arts (group 6) at Kaisei.

Students are expected to spend 150 contact hours in the DP. Study of musical perception is compulsory. One of the following options; creating or solo performing, would be chosen to fulfill the subject requirements.

Students develop their aural perception and understanding of music by learning musical elements, notations, musical terminology and context in different areas. Students are expected to analyze and examine the key features and connections of music from different cultures. Students are able to do the Listening test and the Musical links investigation by the end of this course.

During the course, students prepare a portfolio of compositions or performances. 2 compositions or a 15-minute recital is required to show the process of learning at the end of the course.



Visual Arts

Overview

Visual Arts (SL) is presented as six academic areas enclosing a central core for IB. The IB recommends 150 hours for (SL) in DP. A picture says a thousand words.

Many skills are developed, especially those of critical thinking, analysis, communication, and technique. Students develop their perception of art and understanding of the art world by learning elements of art, art terminology, and context in different areas. Students are expected to analyze and examine the art world from different cultures. Students are able to do investigation, presentation, and develop works of art by the end of this course.

During the course, students prepare a Comparative study, Process Portfolio, and Exhibition. At the end of the course, students' are measured by means of external assessment and internal assessment. A 15 minute presentation of the students' original art work.
